ON TRAVELLER'S VEHICLE PERMITS MARCH, 1950

Foreign vehicles entering Canada on traveller's vehicle permits in March totalled 47.700, an advance of 3 per cent over the same month last year. New Brunswick continued to show a high rate of increase with a gain of 52 per cent. There were increases in the number of entries through all provinces except Quebec and Alberta which showed small declines. Totals for the first three months were up 7 per cent.
