VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA
ON TRAVELLER'S VEHICLE PERMITS
JUNE, 1950

The drop below the previous year which occurred in the number of foreign vehicles entering Canada on traveller's vehicle permits in May was not continued in June. The volume of traffic in June was 8 per cent heavier than in the same month last year, with increases in all provinces except Nova Scotia and Manitoba. Cumulative totals for the first six months were 3 per cent greater than in 1949. Corresponding totals in 1949 were 14 per cent greater than in 1948.
