VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA
ON TRAVELLER'S VEHICLE PERMITS

AUGUST, 1950

The increase over the previous year which occurred in the number of foreign vehicles entering Canada on traveller's vehicle permits in June and July was more moderate in August. The total volume of traffic at 437,200 vehicles was 3 per cent heavier than in August of last year. Cumulative totals for the eight months amounted to 3 per cent more than the corresponding period of 1949. Percentage changes on cumulative data varied from -20 per cent in Manitoba to *20 per cent in New Brunswick.
