VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS

JANUARY 1967

Travellers' vehicle permits issued for the admission of foreign vehicles into Canada during January 1967 numbered 376,028, an increase of 33,323 or 9.7 per cent over January 1966. This represents a new record for the first month of the year. All provinces show an increase with the exception of New Brunswick and entries direct into Newfoundland.
