OCTOBER 1967

The trend toward substantial gains in entries of vehicles registered in other countries was uninterrupted during the month of October. Total entries amounted to 957,185, an increase of 161,281 or 20.3 per cent over October 1966. Once again the gain was highest in Quebec, although entries into Manitoba, Alberta and British Columbia were considerably higher than last year. Cumulative data for the period of January - October show a total of 11,023,485 entries, some 1,278,090 or 13.1 per cent more than in 1966.
