Entries of vehicles registered in other countries totalled 673,193 in November, an increase of 67,702 or 11.2 per cent higher than November 1966. The greatest percentage increase appeared in Alberta where entries were nearly 56 per cent over the same month of last year. Cumulative data for the first eleven months show an increase of 1,345,792 or 13 per cent higher than the same period of 1966.
