Entries of vehicles registered in other countries numbered 1,453,343 in June, an increase of 269,318 or 22.7 per cent in excess of June 1966. About 65 per cent of this increase appeared in Quebec which accounted for 174,622 of the overall increase. Cumulative data for the first half of the year show an increase of 453,485, of which 324,482 was in the province of Quebec, reflecting, no doubt, the influence of Expo on international travel to Canada.
