Entries of vehicles registered in other countries totalled 1,973,668 in August, an increase of 209,515 or 11.9 per cent over August 1966. Substantial increases continued for Quebec (153.1 per cent) and Manitoba (46.9 per cent) while the trend in other provinces varied between gains and declines. Cumulative data for the first eight months show an increase of 916,428 entries, of which 778,416 or 84.9 per cent was in the province of Quebec.


