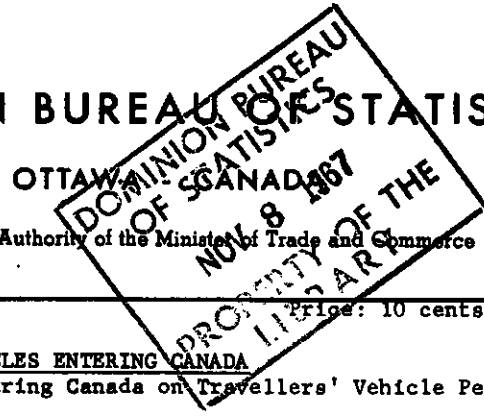


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NON-RESIDENT VEHICLES ENTERING CANADA Formerly - Volume of Highway Traffic Entering Canada on Travellers' Vehicle Permits

SEPTEMBER 1967

The influx of vehicles registered in other countries continued during September 1967 and a total of 1,267,741 entries was recorded. This represents a gain of 200,381 or 18.8 per cent over September 1966. Again considerable increases appear for Quebec (129.9 per cent) and Manitoba (39.4 per cent) while Ontario, after decreases in July and August, registered an increase of 7.3 per cent. Cumulative data for the period January - September show a total of 10,066,300 entries, some 1,116,809 or 12.5 per cent more than in 1966.
