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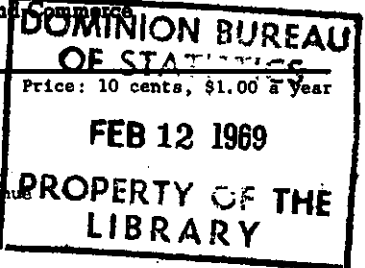

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NON-RESIDENT(1) VEHICLES ENTERING CANADA

DECEMBER 1968

Entries of vehicles registered in other countries totalled 637,538 in December, a decrease of 37,191 or 5.5 per cent below 1967. At the same time, there was an increase of 6,298 or 5.6 per cent in the long-term traffic. Data for the calendar year show a decline of 304,664 or 2.5 per cent in comparison with 1967 but an increase of 1,157,845 or 10.6 per cent if compared with 1966. Cumulative data in long-term entries for April - December show a decline of 526,412 or 13.8 per cent under 1967.

Note: Post administrative procedures used prior to March 1, 1967 appear to have resulted in an overstatement of vehicles staying one or more nights in Canada and a corresponding understatement of same day traffic.
