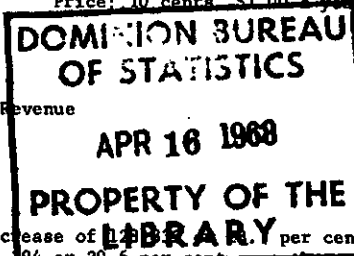

Entries of vehicles registered in other countries numbered 577,088 in February, an increase of 28.7 per cent in excess of February 1967. Cumulative data for January and February show an increase of 192,294 or 20.6 per cent over the same period of last year.
