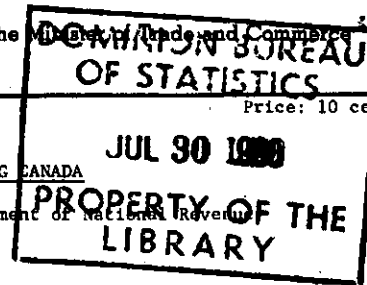

Entries of vehicles registered in other countries numbered 1,310,274 in June, a decrease of 143,078 or 9.8 per cent lower than the corresponding month of 1967. Percentage-wise the decline was most pronounced in Quebec although entries into Manitoba and Ontario were lower than last year. All other provinces registered gains over 1967. Cumulative data for the first half year show a gain of 132,575 or 2.8 per cent with all provinces sharing except Quebec where the decrease amounted to 21.4 per cent.

Note: Port administrative procedures used prior to March 1, 1967 appear to have resulted in an overstatement of vehicles staying one or more nights in Canada and a corresponding understatement of same day traffic.
