## NON-RESIDENT(1) VEHICLES ENTERING CANADA

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JULY 1968

Entries of vehicles registered in other countries numbered 1,883,133 in July 1968, a decrease of 263,706 or 12.3 per cent below the figure for 1967. The percentage decline was largest in Quebec where entries were down by 46.6 per cent. Vehicles entering Manitoba showed a decrease of 20.3 per cent and in Ontario entries were lower by 7.9 per cent. Cumulative data of total entries for the period January-July show a decrease of 131,131 vehicles or 1.9 per cent, with all provinces recording gains except Quebec where a decrease of 30.9 per cent was recorded.
