Entries of vehicles registered in other countries totalled 538,784 in January, a decrease of 11,823 or 2.1 per cent compared with January 1968. However, vehicles remaining one or more nights in Canada (long-term traffic) show an increase of 8,337 or 12.5 per cent over the previous year.
