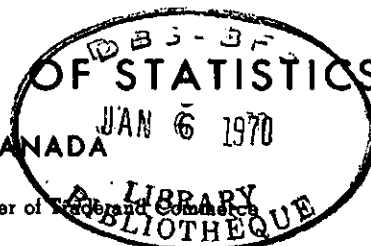

NON-RESIDENT(1) VEHICLES ENTERING CANADASource: Reports from Border Offices of the Department of National Revenue

NOVEMBER 1969

An increase of 17,231 vehicles or 2.4 per cent was recorded in the number of non-resident vehicles entering Canada during November 1969. Entries in the long-term category were up some 4.7 per cent over November of last year. Totals for the period January - November show an increase of 1.5 per cent in the aggregate while long-term traffic increased almost 5 per cent.
