## MARCH 1969

Entries of vehicles registered in other countries totalled 652,273 in March, a decrease of 2.5 per cent or 16,857 **ever** the corresponding month of 196**9**. There was an increase of 7.7 per cent in the long-term entries which numbered 106,665. Cummulative data for the first quarter of 1969 show 1,756,121 entries as compared with 1,796,852 in the same period of 1968, representing a decrease of 2.3 per cent.
