A total of 1,054,979 vehicles registered in other countries entered Canada during the month of May 1970, an increase of 2.0 per cent above the 1969 figure. Vehicles remaining one or more nights numbered 290,990, an increase of 1.1 per cent. Total cumulative data for the period January to May are 4.7 per cent above last years total while long-term traffic has increased by 7.5 per cent.
