A total of $2,043,461$ vehicles registered in other countries entered Canada during the month of July 1970, an increase of 4.3 per cent above the 1969 figure. Vehicles remaining one or more nights numbered 902,166 , an increase of 11.5 per cent. Total cumulative data for the period January to July are 4.4 per cent above last years total while long-term traffic has increased by 8.8 per cent.
