A total of $1,219,578$ vehicles registered in other countries entered Canada during the month of September 1970, an increase of 16.0 per cent above the 1969 figure. Vehicles remaining one or more nights numbered 450,913 , an increase of 28.2 per cent. Total cumulative data for the period January to September is 4.6 per cent above last years total while long-term traffic has increased 9.0 per cent.
