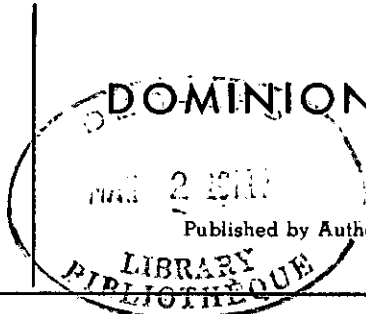

JANUARY 1971

A total of 584,768 non-resident vehicles entered Canada during January 1971, decreasing 1.6 per cent versus 1970. Long-term traffic edged up over 1970 to total 90,964 vehicles, an increase of 1.0 per cent. Most provinces showed decreases in long-term traffic except Ontario which increased by 4.8 per cent.
