Total non-resideftemieke Eraffic and total long-term traffic for the month of June decreased slightly from last year. Cumulative totals for the January - June 1971 period, show that 4,986,000 non-resident vehicles entered Canada, a slight decrease from last year. Cumulative long-term traffic increased 2.4 per cent with the largest absolute increase being recorded in Ontario ( 29,250 entries).
