AUGUST 1971

A total of 2,101,000 non-resident vehicles entered Canada in August 1971, a slight increase from August last year. Long-term vehicle entries numbered 919,200, a 1.8 per cent increase. Aggregate totals for the January-August 1971 period show that total long-term vehicle traffic increased 4.8 per cent, whereas total non-resident vehicle entries over the same period show no significant change.
