

Live births in Canada during the first quarter of 1932 numbered 58,355 (preliminary figures) giving an equivalent annual rate of 22.3 per 1,000 population, as compared with 59,602 births and a rate of 23.3 for the first quarter of 1931. Deaths totalled 27,728 with a rate of 10.6 as against 28,655 and a rate of 11.2 for the corresponding period of last year. There were 11,217 marriages during the quarter as compared with 11,300 in the first quarter of 1931, and the rate was 4.3 as against 4.4. Stillbirths numbered 1977 as compared with 2,008, forming in each case 3.3 per cent of all births. The number of deaths under one year of age was 4,362, a rate of 74.7 per 1,000 live births. These figures compare with 5,597 infant deaths and a rate of 93.9 in the first quarter of 1931. There were 305 maternal deaths, giving a rate of 5.2 per 1,000 live births, as against 348 maternal deaths and a rate of 5.8 in the corresponding period last year.

The number of deaths assigned to certain causes in the first quarter of 1932 was as follows (in each case the figures for the corresponding period of 1931 are given in parentheses): Typhoid and paratyphoid fever 65 (61); Smallpox 16 (2); Measles 109 (540); Scarlet fever 66 (84); Diphtheria 138 (192); Influenza 1373 (1817); Infantile paralysis 19 (14); Tuberculosis 1862 (2096); Cancer 2543 (2335); Diseases of the heart 4091 (3649); Diseases of the arteries 1852 (1656); Pneumonia 2275 (2905); Diarrhoea and enteritis 581 (612); Nephritis 1561 (1343); Suicide 205 (224); Homicide 45 (39); Automobile accidents 169 (155); Other violence 885 (842).
