Live births in Canada during the third quarter of 1932 numbered 59,225 (preliminary figures) giving an equivalent annual rate of 22.4 per 1,000 population as compared with 61,591 births and a rate of 23.6 for the third quarter of 1931. Deaths totalled 23,080 with a rate of 8.7 as against 24,707 and a rate of 9.5 for the corresponding period of last year. There were 17,189 marriages during the quarter as compared with 19,223 in the third quarter of 1931, and the rate was 6.5 as against 7.4. Deaths under one year of age numbered 4,214 giving a rate of 71.2 per 1,000 live births against 5,338 and a rate of 86.7. There were 266 maternal deaths as compared with 261, and the rate was 4.5 as against 4.2 per 1,000 births.

The number of deaths assigned to certain causes in the third quarter of 1932 was as follows (in each case the figures for the corresponding period of 1931 are given in parentheses): Typhoid and paratyphoid fever 102 (148); Smallpox - (-); Measles 22 (21); Scarlet fever 37 (39); Diphtheria 64 (112); Influenza 253 (198); Infantile paralysis 86 (99); Tuberculosis 1,551 (1,776); Cancer 2,456 (2,412); Diseases of the heart 3,225 (2,984); Diseases of the arteries 1,485 (1,258); Pneumonia 929 (787); Diarrhoea and enteritis 1,614 (2,592); Nephritis 1,231 (1,171); Suicide 283 (270); Homicide 33 (39); Automobile accidents 371 (456); Other violence 1,298 (1,647).

For the first nine months of 1932 the figures are as follows, with those for the corresponding period of 1931 in parentheses: Live births 176,147 (184,218); Birth rate 22.4 (23.8); Deaths 77,411 (79,223); Death rate 9.9 (10.2); Marriages 44,547 (48,504); Marriage rate 5.7 (6.3); Deaths under one year 12,763 (15,628); Infant death rate 72.5 (84.8); Maternal deaths 855 (929); Maternal death rate 4.9 (5.0).

Deaths from certain causes for the nine months were as follows: Typhoid and paratyphoid fever 251 (280); Smallpox 17 (1); Measles 278 (129); Scarlet fever 151 (186); Diphtheria 282 (416); Influenza 2,991 (2,819); Infantile paralysis 122 (144); Tuberculosis 5,440 (6,008); Cancer 7,430 (7,173); Diseases of the heart 11,194 (10,047); Diseases of the arteries 5,043 (4,470); Pneumonia 4,954 (5,454); Diarrhoea and enteritis 2,786 (3,838); Nephritis 4,182 (3,791); Suicide 779 (763); Homicide 119 (133); Automobile accidents 750 (924); Other violence 3,296 (3,701).
