Live births in Canada during the second quarter of 1933 numbered 57,647 (preliminary figures) giving an equivalent annual rate of 21.7 per 1,000 population as compared with 59,826 births and a rate of 22.9 for the second quarter of 1932. Deaths totalled 25,418 with a rate of 9.6 as against 26,917 and a rate of 10.3 for the corresponding period of last year. There were 15,674 marriages during the quarter as compared with 16,303 in the second quarter of 1932, and the rate was 5.9 as against 6.2. Deaths under one year of age numbered 4,020 giving a rate of 69.7 per 1,000 live births against 4,248 and a rate of 71.0. There were 298 maternal deaths as compared with 301, and the rate was 5.2 as against 5.0 per 1,000 live births.

The number of deaths assigned to certain causes in the second quarter of 1933 was as follows (in each case the figures for the corresponding period of 1932 are given in parentheses): Typhoid and paratyphoid fever 54 (87); Smallpox 3 (1); Measles 57 (148); Scarlet fever 28 (48); Diphtheria 47 (80); Influenza 602 (1,374); Infantile paralysis 12 (17); Tuberculosis 1,900 (2,092); Cancer 2,691 (2,466); Diseases of the heart 3,883 (3,913); Diseases of the arteries 1,714 (1,712); Pneumonia 1,597 (1,764); Diarrhoea and enteritis 625 (598); Nephritis 1,501 (1,401); Suicides 267 (294); Homicides 40 (43); Automobile accidents 196 (220); Other violence 1,148 (1,157).

For the first six months of 1933 the figures are as follows, with those for the corresponding period of 1932 in parentheses: Live births 113,293 (119,572); Birth rate 21.5 (22.9); Deaths 53,821 (54,922); Death rate 10.2 (10.5); Marriages 26,220 (27,613); Marriage rate 5.0 (5.3); Deaths under one year 8,769 (8,667); Infant death rate 77.4 (72.5); Maternal deaths 585 (621); Maternal death rate 5.2 (5.2).

Deaths from certain causes for the six months were as follows: Typhoid and paratyphoid fever 96 (155); Smallpox 5 (17); Measles 105 (259); Scarlet fever 86 (115); Diphtheria 114 (219); Influenza 3,200 (2,756); Infantile paralysis 27 (35); Tuberculosis 3,714 (3,978); Cancer 5,266 (5,032); Diseases of the heart 8,043 (8,034); Diseases of the arteries 3,606 (3,577); Pneumonia 3,963 (4,073); Diarrhoea and enteritis 1,152 (1,179); Nephritis 2,937 (2,965); Suicides 471 (503); Homicides 75 (89); Automobile accidents 342 (401); Other violence 2,004 (2,068).
