AGRICULTURAL REVENUE AND WEALTH OF CANADA, 1934 and 1935

Ottawa, April 16, 1936.- The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issued to-day preliminary estimates for 1935 and revised estimates for 1934 of (1) the gross agricultural revenue of Canada; (2) the net agricultural revenue of Canada; (3) the gross agricultural wealth of Canada.


Gross Annual Agricultural Revenue, 1934 and 1935

In Table 1 is given, by provinces, an estimate of the gross agricultural revenue of Canada for the years 1934 and 1935. The estimates for 1935 are preliminary and subject to revision. The estimates for 1934 have been revised upwards for dairy products, fruits and vegetables, poultry and eggs, and fur farming, and downwards for field crops, wool and maple products. No allowance has been made in these calculations for the portions of crops used for seed and in the feeding of live stock. Because of these duplications the totals represent gross values.



The total gross agricultural revenue of Canada is estimated at \$943,081,000 for 1935 as compared with \$942,565,000, the revised estimate for 1934. This represents an increase of only \$516,000 or less than one per cent. Increases are shown in the revenue from farm animals, wool, dairy products, fruits and vegetables, poultry and eggs, maple products, and flax fibre, but these increases are largely offset by the decrease in revenue from field crops, fur farming, tobacco, clover and grass seed, and honey.

The gross agricultural revenue for 1935, by provinces, in order of value, is as follows: Ontario \$313,077,000; Quebec \$174,758,000; Saskatchewan \$154,896,000; Alberta \$141,093,000; Manitoba \$56,530,000; British Columbia \$38,010,000; Nova Scotia \$27,042,000; New Brunswick \$25,278,000; Prince Edward Island \$12,397,000.



NET ANNUAL AGRICULTURAL REVENUE OF CANADA, 1934 and 1935

The net annual agricultural revenue is estimated by deducting from the gross revenue the value of such items as feed for farm animals and poultry, seed and unmerchant-able grain, and vegetables produced on farms for home use. The preliminary estimate of the net agricultural revenue for 1935 is placed at \$609,318,000, as compared with \$577,952,000, the revised estimate for 1934, an increase of \$31,366,000, or 5.4 per cent.

GROSS AGRICULTURAL WEALTH OF CANADA, 1934 and 1935

Table 11 shows approximately, by provinces, the gross agricultural wealth of the Dominion for the years 1934 and 1935. The figures for 1935 are preliminary and subject to revision.

In these tables, full use is made of the results of the 1931 census for values of lands, buildings, and implements and machinery. The figures quoted for buildings, and implements and machinery correspond with the values shown in the census returns, as these items change very little in value from year to year. The estimated values for lands are weighted by the annual estimates of farm land values. The other items - live stock, poultry, animals on farms and agricultural production - are annual estimates.

The gross agricultural wealth of Canada for 1935 is estimated at \$5,797,104,000 as compared with \$5,620,173,000 in 1934, an increase of \$176,931,000 or 3.1 per cent.
