### CLASSIFYING TRADE BY COUNTRY

### Why Classify by Country.

Export and import trade involves the movement of goods between Canada and some other country, and proper identification of the other country involved in each transaction is essential if trade statistics are to serve their many purposes. The businessman who uses trade statistics as a source of market information needs to know not only what goods can be bought and sold abroad, but also in what countries he may be able to buy or sell the particular commodities in which he is interested. The government, in managing commercial relations with other countries, needs to know both the extent of Canada's trade with other countries and the particular commodities involved if its efforts in trade promotion and tariff negotiation are to have useful results. And economists concerned with the analysis of economic conditions need to know what is involved in Canada's trade with other important countries in order to assess the effects on the Canadian economy of developments abroad.

#### What Frinciples are Used?

In Canadian statistics trade is credited according to country of consignment. This means that for any export shipment we show the last destination known at the time of export, for any import shipment (with one general exception) the country from which the goods were first directed to Canada. Country of consignment is only one of several possible systems of crediting trade by country; other systems which still are used elsewhere are as follows:-

Exports by country of consumption, imports by country of origin. Exports by country of sale, imports by country of purchase. Exports and imports by country of shipment.

The Statistical Commission of the United Nations has endorsed an experts report recommending country of consignment on the grounds that this system gives maximum comparability in the records of partner countries and is the easiest to adminster accurately and without delays in the production of statistics.

Canadian customs regulations provide that the country of consignment is to be shown on the entry form that documents any movement of goods to or from another country. Therefore, in our records transactions are always credited to the country shown on the customs entry unless there is good reason to believe that the entry was incorrectly prepared. The only general exception to this rule is that imports consigned to Canada from the United States, but which are shown by the customs invoice to have originated in Central or South America, are credited by country of origin as shown on the invoice. In such cases import signal 6 is used to indicate these exceptions to the general rule on classifying trade by country.

(After our regular tabulations have been completed the import S.6 cards are sorted and tabulated separately in order to measure the effect of this procedure on statistics of trade with the countries involved. The results of this analysis are published in the Review of Foreign Trade and in Trade of Canada, Vol. I.).

### The Design of our Classification:

The classification of countries introduced on January 1, 1960, and the code system embodied in this classification, are designed to deal with several problems which previously hampered our operations. A brief description of the classification and code should help members of the Section to use these tools properly.

The classification of countries is based on a division of the world into geographic regions. Other bases for a classification are possible; our former classification was based on political considerations, that used by the International Monetary Fund is based on financial considerations. However both political and financial conditions are subject to rapid change, and in a basic statistical operation such as ours the use of either of these alternative approaches could easily require frequent major alterations in the classification to keep our statistics up-to-date. The geographic basis for country classification has been recommended by both the United Nations Statistical Office and the International Statistical Institute, and is used in practice by such leading countries as the United States and the United Kingdom.

In addition to permanency, the geographic approach to country classification is expected to yield other important advantages. We have found that new recruits to this staff rarely have much knowledge of geography, and even experienced coders formerly had difficulty in locating many countries on a map. The classification of countries and the country code now indicate where any country is located, and this should aid in carrying out procedures of the import S.6 type. The geographic approach divides countries into relatively small sub-groups which will facilitate partial revisions of the classification and probably render unnecessary another complete revision of the classification within the foreseable future. The grouping of geographically related countries also eases the preparation of summaries of our statistics on a geographical basis (which often must be done by hand), and may have some advantages in the development of audit techniques.

### The Design of our Code:

In the design of the code of countries several conditions had to be satisfied:

(1) The code had to consist of as few digits as possible, since the greater the number of digits the more difficult it is to learn, and the more work it creates in machine sorting.

- (2) The code had to permit the separation of transactions with the United States and the United Kingdom on a single sort. This simplifies and speeds the mechanical tabulation of our statistics.
- (3) The code had to permit the tabulation of totals both for geographic regions and for Commonwealth and other countries.
- (4) The code had to list the United Kingdom first and the United States last. This arrangement is very convenient for users of our published reports.
- (5) The code had to be flexible to ensure that future revisions would cause little difficulty.

The minimum number of digits we can have in our country code is 3, since more than 100 countries have to be specified individually. To avoid unnecessary difficulties the code of countries was therefore designed with three digits as follows:

(1) The first digit of the code indicates geographic region.
Nine regions are presently in use:

Note that one spare number (1) is reserved for predictable revisions in the allocation of first digits to Europe. To facilitate such changes no two European countries (Western and Eastern together) were assigned the same last pair of digits in their code. Note also that a maximum of ten geographic regions can be accommodated within this system.

(2) The second digit of the code indicates the traditional political classification of countries:

Since no country other than the United Kingdom has 0 in the second digit, and no country other than the United States has 9, this digit permits to elimination of U.S. and U.K. cards in a single sort. As in the first digit, one number (3) is reserved for possible expansion of either the Commonwealth or the "Others" segments beyond the limits initially set in the code. This digit of the code also provides an approximate indication of the column of the customs tariff applicable to imports from any country.

(3) The third digit of the code serves to distinguish individual countries (each country was numbered alphabetically within its Regional-Political sub-group), and also provides a second field in which U.K. and U.S. cards can be eliminated on a single sort, as follows:

0 - United States
1 - United Kingdom
2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 - All others

Ten different numbers can be used in each digit of a 3-digit series, and therefore such a series provides 1000 different combinations of numbers (10x10x10=1000). However by reserving one number in the first digit (1) and one in the second digit (3) for possible future use, and by reserving another two in the second digit (0 and 9) and two in the third (0 and 1) for the United States and the United Kingdom, the number of combinations that we can use as codes is reduced to 506 (9x7x8+2=506). Of the remainder, 358 are permanently unavailable, 136 held in reserve. These figures can be demonstrated as follows:

### Permanently Unavailable:

- (1) Only the U.S. and the U.K. can use 0 and 1 in the third digit, therefore only 8 numbers are otherwise available in the third digit. Since any number will occur 100 times in the third digit of a 3-digit series, this renders 198 combinations unavailable as codes (10x10x10-10x10x8+2=198).
- (2) Only the U.K. and the U.S. can use 0 and 9 in the second digit, therefore only 8 numbers are otherwise available in the second digit. Since any second digit could otherwise enter 80 different combinations of numbers, this renders an additional 160 combinations unavailable as codes (10x10x8-10x8x8=160).

Total Permanently Unavailable: 358.

## Temporarily Unavailable:

- (3) The number 3 is also reserved in the second digit, which further reduces to 7 the numbers otherwise available in the second digit. This renders a further 80 codes temporarily unavailable (10x3x8-10x7x8=80).
- (4) The number 1 is reserved in the first digit, therefore only 9 numbers are otherwise available in the first digit. This renders a final 56 combinations of numbers temporarily unavailable (10x7x8-9x7x8=56).

Of the 506 combinations of numbers available to us, we are now using 131 as codes (26%) whereas our 1959 classification used 127 of 202 available combinations (65%). The available combinations of numbers, and the codes in use in both classifications can be summarized as follows:

A further indication of the flexibility of our new code is that of 16 combinations of numbers available for the Commonwealth sub-group in any area, the maximum in use is 10 (62.5%); of 40 combinations available for the Others sub-group the maximum in use is 16 (40%). To provide suitable codes for additional countries in any sub-group is clearly easy, whereas to provide suitable codes for the countries added in 1960 within our 1959 classification framework would have required the re-numbering of over 100 countries! (The only real additional complication involved in the complete replacement of our 1959 classification was that 12 codes in the new 300 series were used with different meanings in 1959; all members of the staff should therefore be especially careful in using this series of codes).

### Specification of Individual Countries:

In developing the country classification and code we attempted to take account both of the requests of users of our statistics for additional country information and of our own need to eliminate countries for which statistics were unduly difficult to compile, misleading, or of little real value. The original draft of the classification was circulated throughout the Trade Commissioner Service, and several changes were made to ensure that country specifications corresponded to the territories for which particular Trade Commissioners were responsible, and to ensure that the classification was sufficiently detailed for trade promotion work. As a result of this process several new countries were added to the classification, and some formerly specified were deleted.

In drafting and reviewing the classification we were guided by two criteria, which will also be used to guide future revisions:

- (1) Total trade between Canada and each country specified should exceed \$100,000 per year.
- (2) Available documentation must be adequate to compile accurate statistics of trade between Canada and each country specified.

### References for Use:

Several references have been prepared to help all members of the staff understand the country classification and code and use it efficiently. In addition to this memorantum and the two summary tables attached, the following are available to all members of the staff:

- (1) Classification of Countries for External Trade Statistics (In effect January 1, 1960).
- (2) Two reference cards for desk stands, one listing the countries alphabetically, one numerically (both dated Jan.1, 1960).
- (3) Index to Country Code (in effect Jan.1, 1960). This index contains place names that may be encountered in coding, together with their proper code.

Revised pages for these references will be issued as necessary. We are also preparing a set of reference cards which contain indeterminate place names, and our Gazetteers and Atlases will still be available. However all earlier internal references (especially the four page reference entitled "Index of Areas Included in Country Designations") are now obsolete and should be discarded, as should any private references prepared by individual members of the staff to offset the lack of other material. Any inadequacies in the present references should be pointed out to your supervisor for inclusion in future revisions.

#### Country Code and Rates of Duty:

It was mentioned above that the country code provides an approximate indication of the column of the customs tariff applicable to imports from any country. Generally, where the second digit of the country code is 0, 1 or 2, preferential rates will apply; where the second digit is 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 or 9, most-favoured nation rates will apply. This rule is subject to the general exceptions that higher rates of duty may be applied to goods imported from any country depending on the origin of the goods and on their route of shipment to Canada, and that countries entitled to preferential rates are also entitled to M.F.N. rates when these are lower than preferential rates. There are also several specific exceptions which all members of the Import Unit should mark on their desk stand reference cards as follows:-

### Country Code and Import Signal 6:

Members of the Import Unit should note that import signal 6 may apply to goods coded to any country in the 700 or 800 series but not to any country where the first digit of the country code is anything other than 7 or 8. If S.6 is shown for any country except the 700 and 800 series this is a coding error!

This memorandum is intended as a draft of material for inclusion in our projected training manual. Your comments on its suitability for this purpose would be appreciated.
