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MORTALITY BY DETAILED CAUSE OF DEATH 1950-55

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INTRODUCTION

As a member nation of the World Health Organization since its inception, Canada has always subscribed to the use of current versions of standard international lists of causes of death for the portrayal of Canadian mortality. Thus all deaths occurring in Canada since January 1, 1950, have been codified and tabulated according to the Detailed List of the International Statistical Classification of Diseases, Injuries and Causes of Death (6th Revision, 1948).

While the resulting statistics of causes of death for Canada and each province, with distributions according to sex and five-year age groups, are routinely maintained in the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, the degree of specificity afforded by the extensive Detailed List has been considered by the Vital Statistics Council for Canada to be excessively detailed for the primary purpose served by the annual Vital Statistics of Canada — appraisal of the relative importance and trends of the various disease groupings causing death. In consequence, the Bureau's comprehensive annual publication on vital statistics presents data on causes of death according to an international Intermediate List of 150 cause-groups with appropriate cross-classifications.

However, in recognition of the undoubtedly, though limited, need for knowledge of the frequency with which specific disease entities are recorded as causes of death the present report shows in summary form the numbers of deaths for Canada as a whole attributed to each category of the Detailed List during each of the years 1950 to 1955. The Bureau is prepared to supply, on request, data concerning individual detailed causes for each province according to age and sex groupings.

For the convenience of users desiring to calculate rates, the census and estimated mid-year populations for the years covered by the report are as follows:

The frequencies shown in the report and the population figures given above both exclude the Yukon and Northwest Territories.

NOTES

Categories of the International Statistical Classification for which there were no deaths in any year (1950-55) are excluded.

Deaths from certain categories of the Classification are subdivided in Canada into deaths due to "current" infection or due to "late effects" and are distinguished by letters "A" and "B" (see for example, categories 040,041, etc.)
