- → \$43M in prepared vegetables, fruits and nuts
- → \$31M in fresh, chilled or frozen beef

*The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
