BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$15 MILLION IN 2018

- \$695K in chocolate products



HAWAII IMPORTED \$5 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

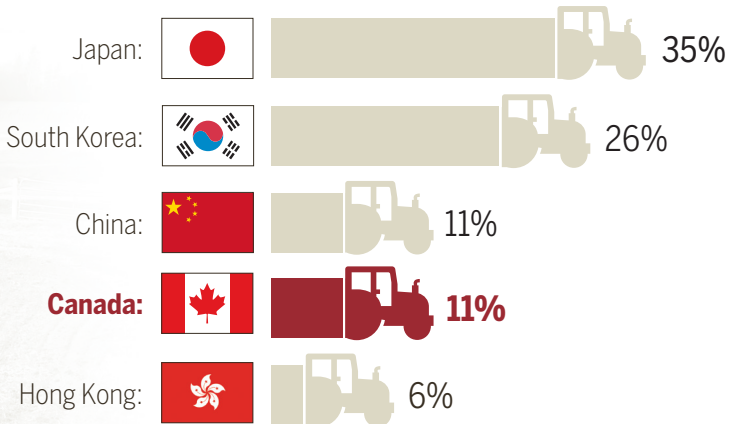
- \$2M in wheat and meslin flour
- \$748K in malt
- \$620K in beverages, spirits and vinegar
- \$445K in food preparations*
- \$199K in live plants

* The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
