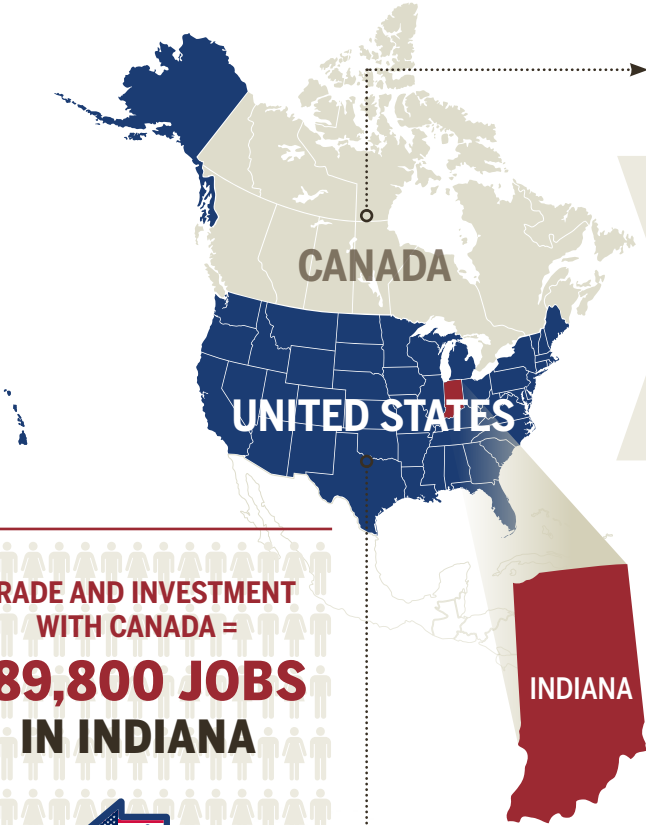

BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$1.1 BILLION IN 2018

INDIANA EXPORTED \$461 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$153M in prepared cereal products (incl. \$58M in baked goods)
- \$56M in food preparations*
- \$48M in beverages, spirits and vinegar
- \$46M in prepared vegetables, fruits and nuts
- \$25M in corn

INDIANA IMPORTED \$675 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

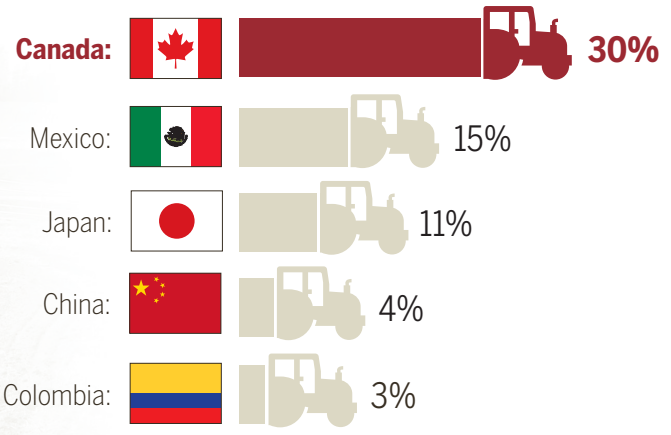
- \$205M in prepared cereal products (incl. \$185M in baked goods)
- \$103M in cocoa and cocoa preparations
- \$80M in canola oil
- \$65M in food preparations*
- \$33M in oil cakes

* The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
