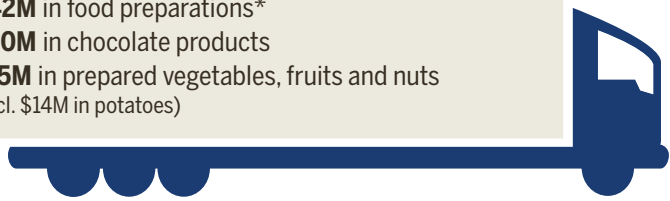

**BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$444 MILLION IN 2018**

**KANSAS EXPORTED \$321 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:**

- \$96M in animal feed
- \$92M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat (incl. \$81M in beef)
- \$42M in food preparations\*
- \$20M in chocolate products
- \$15M in prepared vegetables, fruits and nuts (incl. \$14M in potatoes)



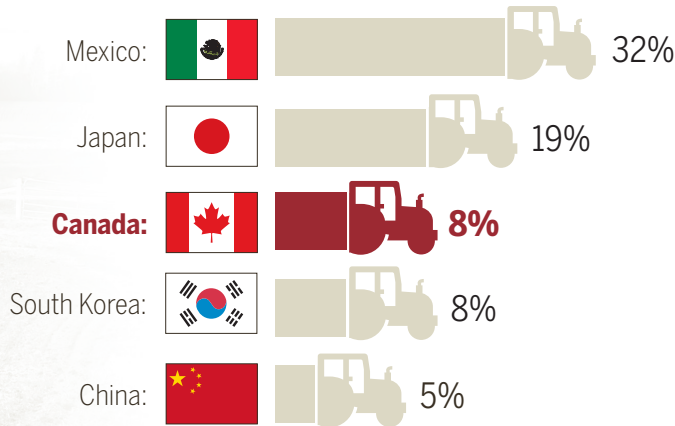
**KANSAS IMPORTED \$123 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:**

- \$16M in live animals (incl. \$9M in cattle)
- \$15M in vegetables
- \$13M in animal feed
- \$11M in fats and oils
- \$10M in cocoa and cocoa preparations

\* The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
