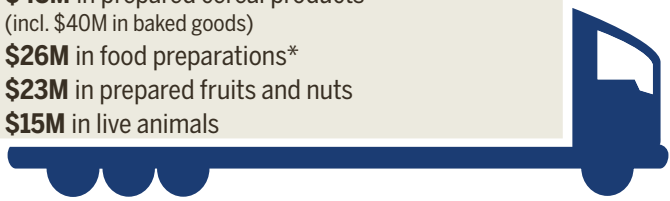

BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$409 MILLION IN 2018

KENTUCKY EXPORTED \$202 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$51M in beverages, spirits and vinegar (incl. \$26M in whiskies)
- \$43M in prepared cereal products (incl. \$40M in baked goods)
- \$26M in food preparations*
- \$23M in prepared fruits and nuts
- \$15M in live animals



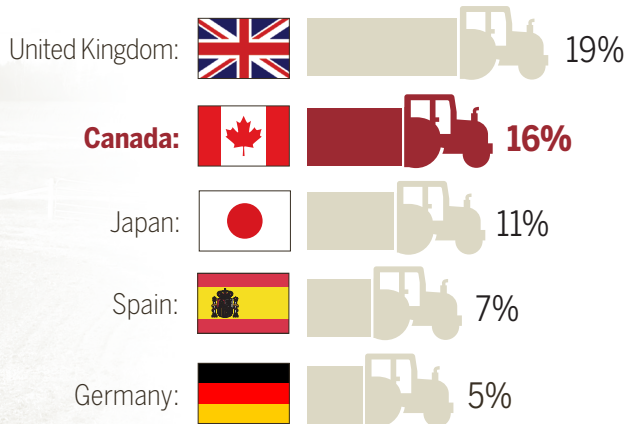
KENTUCKY IMPORTED \$207 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$50M in beverages, spirits and vinegar
- \$23M in baked goods
- \$22M in cereals
- \$20M in cocoa and cocoa preparations
- \$19M in food preparations*

* The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
