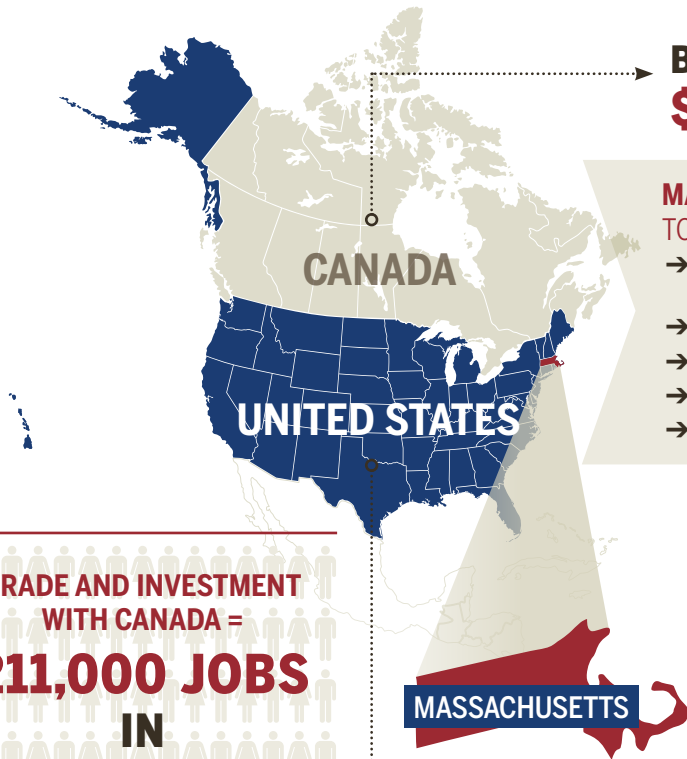

BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$710 MILLION IN 2018

MASSACHUSETTS EXPORTED \$146 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$33M in prepared cereal products (incl. \$19M in baked goods)
- \$17M in food preparations*
- \$16M in prepared vegetables and fruits
- \$14M in fruits and nuts
- \$14M in prepared meat



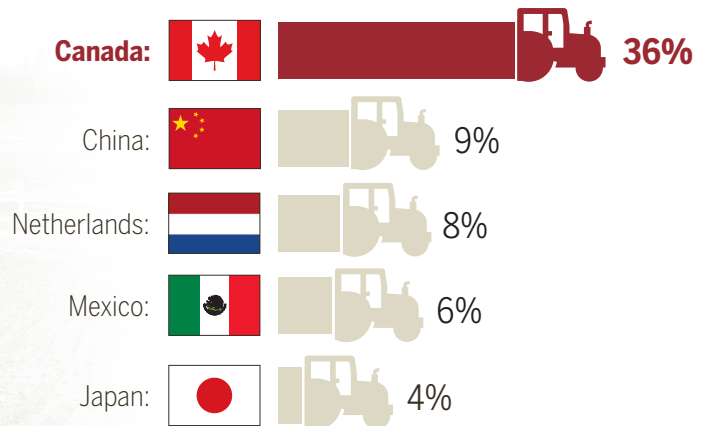
MASSACHUSETTS IMPORTED \$564 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$98M in fats and oils (incl. \$63M in canola oil)
- \$91M in vegetables
- \$90M in prepared cereal products
- \$80M in prepared vegetables, fruits and nuts
- \$50M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat

* The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentratez.
