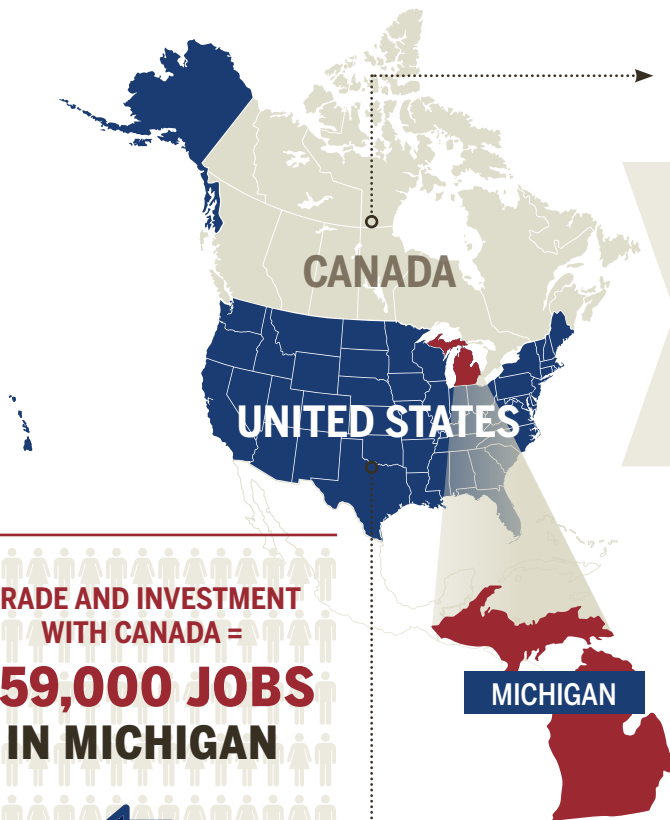

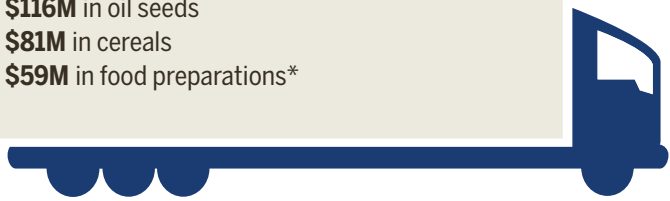

**BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$1.8 BILLION IN 2018**

**MICHIGAN EXPORTED \$808 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:**

- \$163M in prepared cereal products
- \$123M in vegetables
- \$116M in oil seeds
- \$81M in cereals
- \$59M in food preparations\*



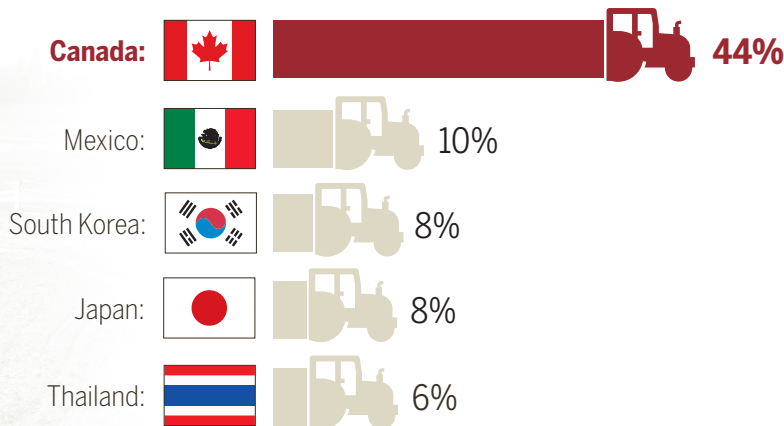
**MICHIGAN IMPORTED \$949 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:**

- \$264M in vegetables
- \$111M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat (incl. \$69M in beef)
- \$90M in animal feed (incl. \$57M in oil cakes)
- \$86M in prepared cereal products
- \$66M in beverages, spirits and vinegar

\* The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
