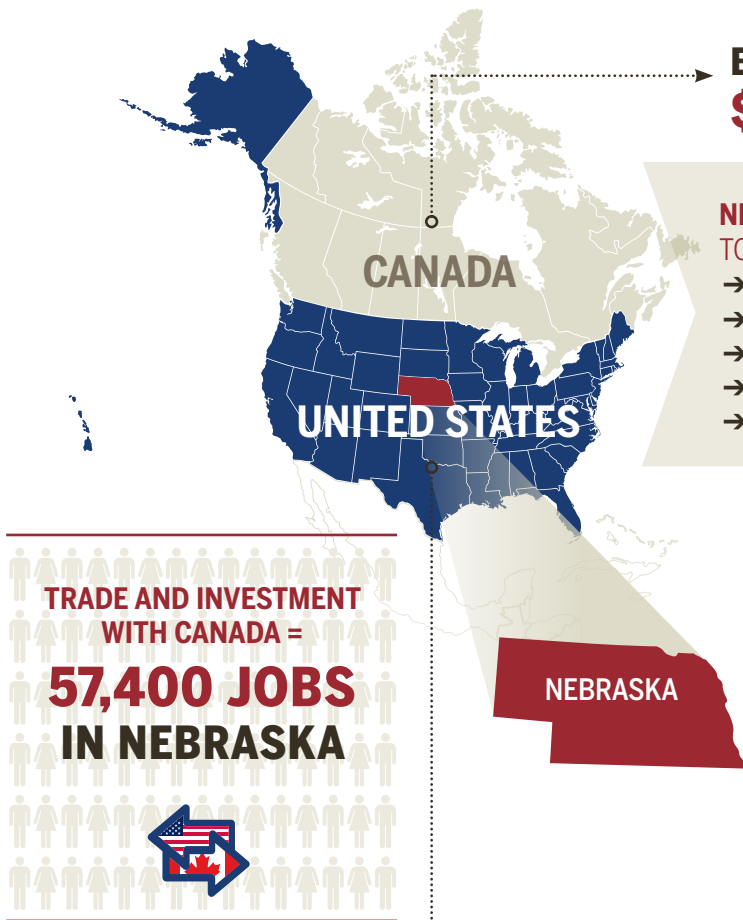

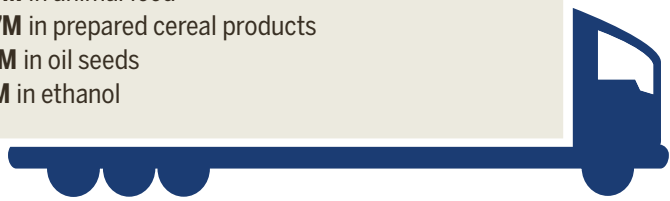

BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$584 MILLION IN 2018

NEBRASKA EXPORTED \$317 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$172M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat
- \$67M in animal feed
- \$27M in prepared cereal products
- \$11M in oil seeds
- \$6M in ethanol

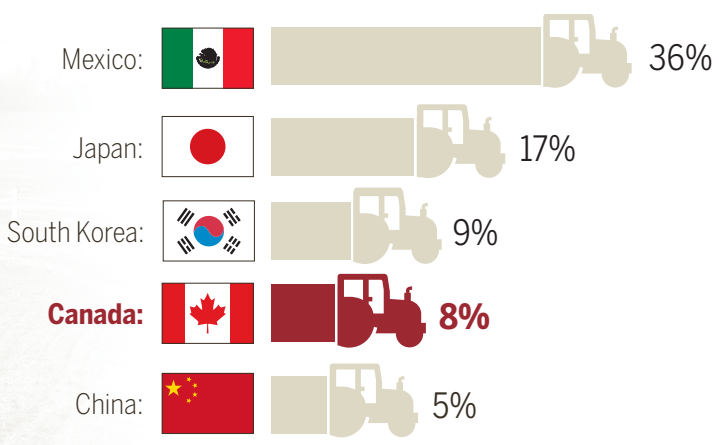


NEBRASKA IMPORTED \$267 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$80M in live animals (incl. \$73M in live cattle)
- \$53M in animal feed
- \$37M in cereals
- \$27M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat
- \$19M in yeasts
