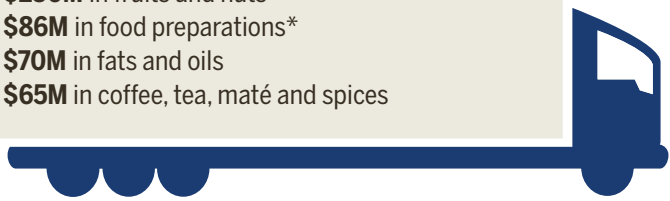

**BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$2.3 BILLION IN 2018**

**NEW JERSEY EXPORTED \$1 BILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:**

- \$254M in prepared vegetables, fruits and nuts
- \$230M in fruits and nuts
- \$86M in food preparations\*
- \$70M in fats and oils
- \$65M in coffee, tea, maté and spices



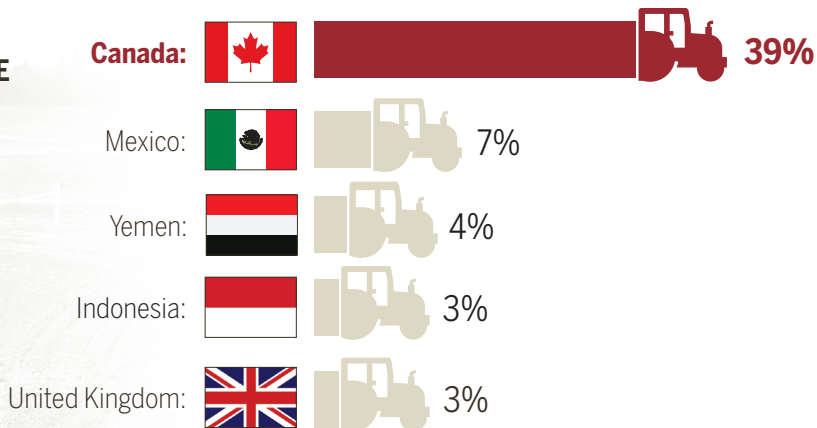
**NEW JERSEY IMPORTED \$1.3 BILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:**

- \$201M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat
- \$198M in prepared cereal products
- \$157M in prepared vegetables, fruits and nuts
- \$131M in fats and oils
- \$105M in coffee

\* The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
