

- → \$121M in beverages, spirits and vinegars
- → \$101M in food preparations*
- → \$80M in animal feed

NEW YORK IMPORTED \$1.8 BILLION

FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- → \$273M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat
- → \$186M in vegetables
- → \$159M in food preparations*
- → \$150M in prepared cereal products
- → \$136M in cocoa and cocoa preparations

*The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
