FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

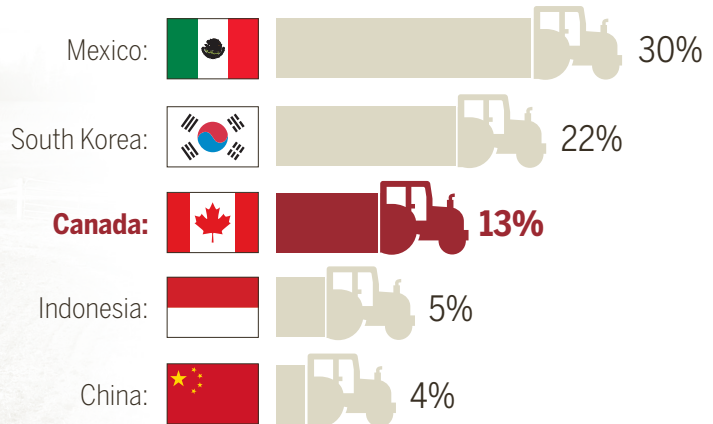
- \$5.8M in animal feed
