

BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$44 MILLION IN 2018

RHODE ISLAND EXPORTED \$9 MILLION

TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- → \$4M in sausages
- → \$3M in coffee
- → \$1M in food preparations*
- → \$293K in prepared cereal products
- → \$290K in prepared vegetables, fruits, and nuts



RHODE ISLAND IMPORTED \$35 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- → \$17M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat (incl. \$15M in pork)
- → \$4M in vegetables
- → \$3M in prepared cereals
- → \$3M in prepared vegetables, fruits and nuts
- → \$1M in food preparations*

*The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
