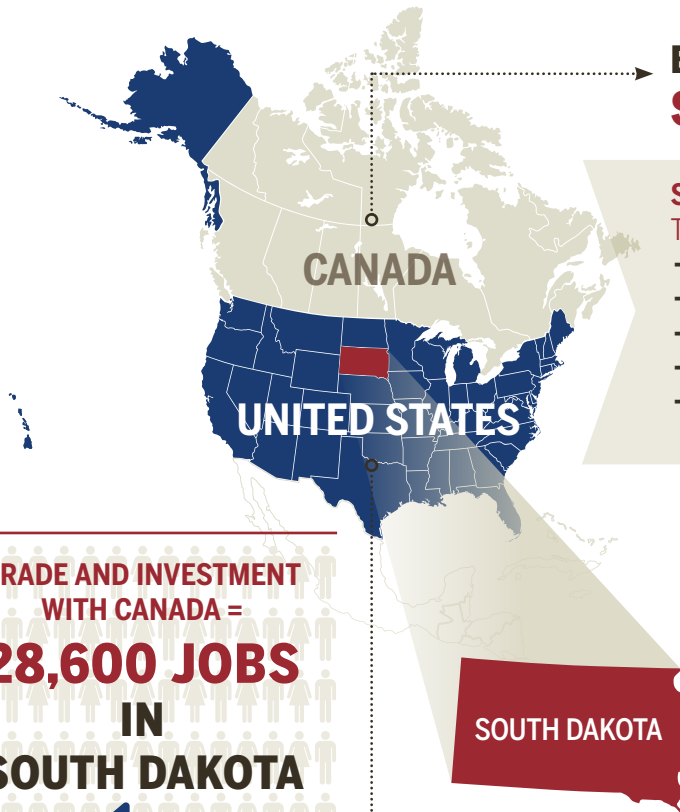

BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$356 MILLION IN 2018

SOUTH DAKOTA EXPORTED \$278 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$85M in oil cakes
- \$70M in ethyl alcohol
- \$51M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat
- \$11M in fats and oils (incl. \$7M in soybean oil)
- \$7M in cereals



SOUTH DAKOTA IMPORTED \$78 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

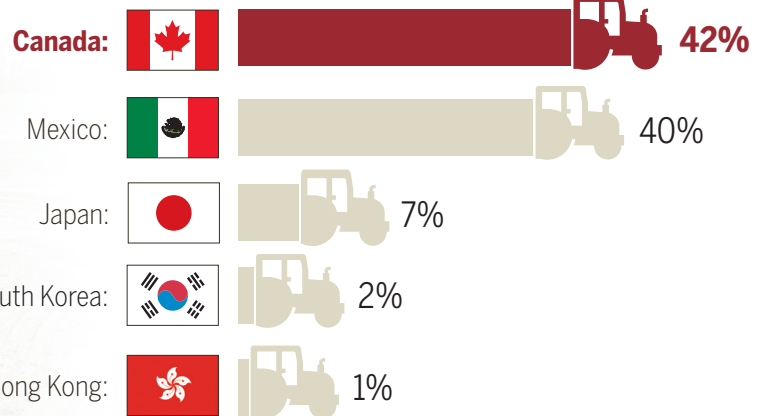
- \$38M in live animals
- \$13M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat (incl. \$11M in beef)
- \$10M in cereals
- \$4M in oil seeds
- \$3M in animal feed
