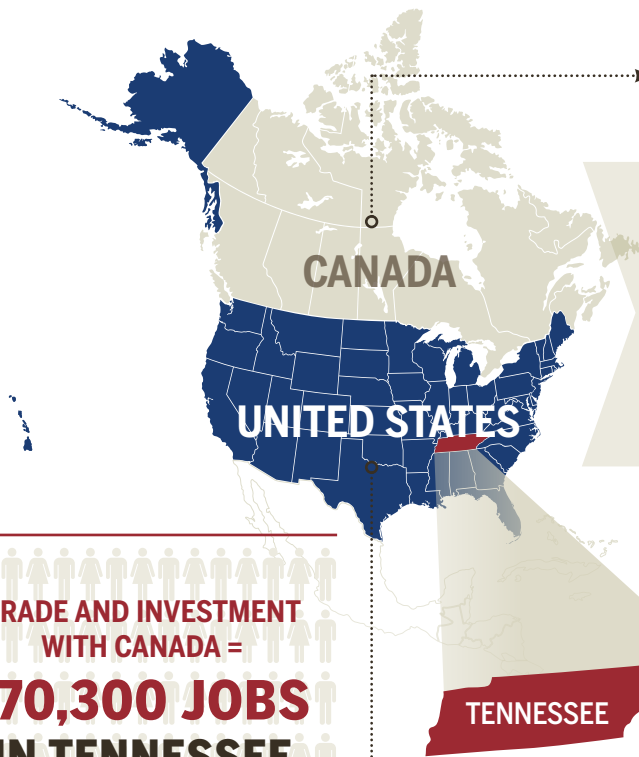

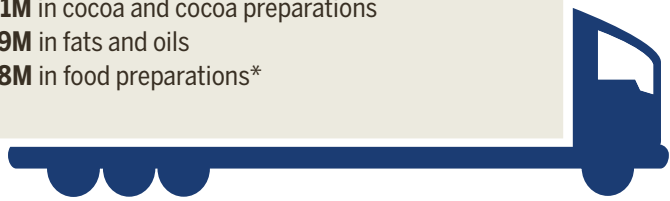

BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$613 MILLION IN 2018

TENNESSEE EXPORTED \$245 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$112M in prepared cereal products
- \$22M in beverages, spirits and vinegar
- \$21M in cocoa and cocoa preparations
- \$19M in fats and oils
- \$18M in food preparations*



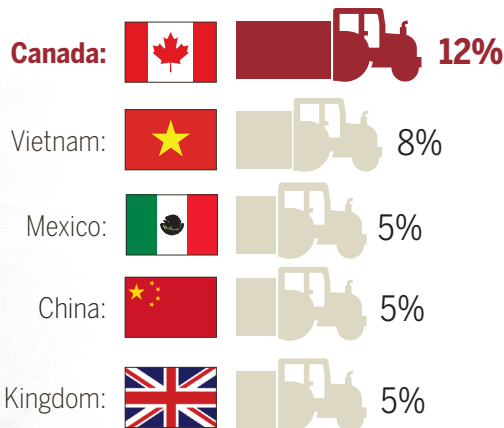
TENNESSEE IMPORTED \$368 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$82M in food preparations*
- \$77M in canola oil
- \$62M in prepared cereal products
- \$25M in sugars and sweets
- \$20M in cocoa and cocoa preparations

* The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
