Reminder

Adjectives – one or two syllables

- adjective + *er* + *than*
(Note: Change *y* to *i* then add *er*.)

tall
pretty

Examples

Jane is **taller than** Mary.
Mary is **prettier than** Jane.

Adjectives – multi syllabic

- more/less + adjective + *than*

beautiful
attractive

Mary is **more beautiful than** Jane.
Jane is **less attractive than** Mary.

Irregular adjectives

- many different forms + *than*

good
bad

My car is **better than** yours.
My cold is **worse than** yours.

As . . . as

- *as* + adjective + *as*

tall
beautiful

Susan is **as tall as** Jane.
Susan is **as beautiful as** Mary.
