

INTRODUCTION AND SCOPE

This report is part of a continuing series of market intelligence reports on specific products and is designed to increase business awareness of the potential existing for production in Canada. It is important, however, to emphasize that this report does not attempt any assessment as to the feasibility of competing in a particular market.





METHANAL (FORMALDEHYDE) AND PARAFORMALDEHYDE

MARKET SUMMARY

Formaldehyde and paraformaldehyde are used primarily in the production of phenolic, urea and melamine resins. These resins are used as binders and adhesives for construction materials such as particleboard (urea-formaldehyde), waferboard and plywood (phenol-formaldehyde) and decorative laminates (melamine formaldehyde). Other applications are in textile finishes, embalming fluids, fungicides, air fresheners, cosmetics and in the manufacture of pentaerythritol for alkyd paints.

Consumption is expected to hold steady over the longer term with some growth possible. Imports are negligible and sufficient production capacity exists to cover small increases in consumption. While exports to the U.S. do not make up a large portion of sales, they may be at risk from the estimated 200 kilotonnes of new formaldehyde capacity coming onstream in the U.S. in 1990.

Due to a variety of economic pressures, the number of housing starts in Canada in 1990 has fallen off from the record numbers of the last two years. This has impacted the use of construction materials and hence formaldehyde consumption. Phenol-formaldehyde based resins are also facing competition in wood bonding markets from diphenyl methane diisocyanate-based polymers.

Formaldehyde use in melamine resins and pentaerythritol may decline as environmental control proposals to reduce volatile organic emissions are introduced. This could result in further substitution of solvent-based alkyd paints by water-based vinyl and acrylic emulsions.

In spite of a pessimistic forecast for mature end markets and concerns over the toxicity of formaldehyde emissions from products and tail pipe exhaust from methanol fuelled vehicles (promoted under "cleaner air" programs), formaldehyde demand is expected to grow slowly over the medium to long terms.
