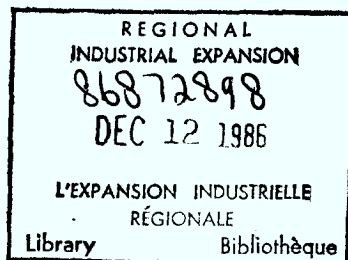

**INDUSTRIAL AND REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM**

**ANNUAL REPORT**

**APRIL 1, 1985, TO MARCH 31, 1986**

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A. INTRODUCTION

The Minister of Regional Industrial Expansion is required, under Section 15 of the Industrial and Regional Development Act, to report to Parliament by the first day of June following each fiscal year on the administration of the act. This third annual report includes an explanation of the Industrial and Regional Development Program (IRDP), and an analysis of the program's operations and trends for fiscal year 1985/86.

Explanation of the terms used in administering the act appears on page 8 of this report.

The IRDP was established in 1983 and superseded a number of industrial assistance programs delivered by the former Departments of Industry, Trade and Commerce and Regional Economic Expansion.

The objective of the IRDP, which is one of the major programs of the Department of Regional Industrial Expansion (DRIE), is to promote regional industrial development through the support of private sector initiatives with particular emphasis on projects, industries and technologies with the greatest potential for economic return, sustained growth and international competitiveness. The program makes financial assistance available to business and non-profit organizations through contributions or repayable contributions. A wide range of projects may be eligible for support under the IRDP including feasibility studies, product and process innovation, new plant establishment, modernization or expansion of existing plant facilities and marketing.

Many worthwhile projects might not proceed because assistance is not available in an appropriate form at a specific stage in their development. The IRDP addresses this need by providing a range of financial support over the major phases or elements of a typical corporate development cycle. The elements of the program are:

- Innovation
- Establishment
- Modernization/Expansion
- Marketing

With few exceptions, applications are received and analysed in the DRIE regional offices, and decision-making for small cases involving contributions of up to \$100 000 in Crown support has been decentralized to these offices. The IRDP responds particularly to the needs of small and medium-sized businesses and complements other federal programs.

Two types of applicants are eligible for support under the IRDP:

- Commercial operations, consisting of manufacturing or processing operations, can apply under the Innovation, Establishment and Modernization/Expansion elements.
- Eligible persons, essentially non-profit organizations carrying on activities in support of commercial operations, can apply under the Innovation and Marketing elements.

Although the program is national in scope, financial assistance is available in all regions of Canada based on four tier groups into which census divisions are classified:

- Tier I consists of the most developed census divisions of the country where approximately 50 percent of the population live.
- Tier II comprises census divisions that are next in line on the development scale and accounts for approximately 30 percent of the population.
- Tier III covers the relatively less developed areas and accounts for approximately 15 percent of the population.
- Tier IV includes the least developed areas in which no more than 5 percent of the population reside.

Financial assistance under the IRDP is scaled in proportion to the tier group level in which the eligible project is located, i.e., the higher the tier level, the greater the maximum possible assistance. Tier group designations are made according to a "development index", which is a measure of economic disparity in the country based on income, unemployment and provincial fiscal capacity indicators in 260 of Canada's census divisions as provided by Statistics Canada.

Tier group designations are reviewed annually on July 1 for possible adjustment depending on changing economic conditions. As a result of the rearranging on July 1, 1985, there were 14 census districts that moved to the next higher tier while 20 moved to the next lower tier.

To address possible short-term economic downturns in a Tier I census district, the program provides for the equivalent of Tier II assistance for the Establishment and Modernization/Expansion elements when the average ratio of unemployment insurance beneficiaries to working-age population in the census district exceeds, by one percentage point, the national average for any consecutive six months. Applications are accepted for one year following designation of an area as Special Tier I.

Assistance takes the form of outright contributions or contributions that are specifically or conditionally repayable. The maximum levels of assistance vary from element to element and, in most elements, increase with the tier levels. Full details are contained in the regulations and program brochure available from any office of the department. Projects entailing Crown support of \$100 000 or less will, if supported, normally be offered the maximum level of assistance. For larger projects, the amount of assistance offered is the estimated minimum necessary to meet the requirements of the project. Particular attention is paid to the capacity utilization in the applicant's industrial sector and impact of the proposed project on other businesses so that the net economic benefits to Canada are maximized with program expenditures. For projects under all elements, the maximum level of assistance from all government sources, including investment tax credits, cannot exceed 90 percent of the project costs.

It should be emphasized that, although IRDP represents the major funded program of DRIE, it is not the only program. Other funded programs include the Defence Industry Productivity Program (DIPP), the Small Businesses Loans Act (SBLA), Special ARDA (Agricultural and Rural Development Act), the Western Transportation Industrial Development Program (WTIDP) and the Native Economic Development Fund (NEDF). In addition, there is a large number of sub-agreements signed with the provinces under the Economic and Regional Development Agreement (ERDA) framework.

Also, funded programs are only one aspect of DRIE. There are many other non-funded activities carried out by the department to encourage industrial development and trade promotion in all regions of Canada.

It should be noted that applications for financial assistance and supporting documentation received under the IRDP and other departmental programs contain information that must be regarded as commercially confidential. For this reason and as a matter of policy, the department does not make public certain types of data. For similar reasons of commercial confidentiality, the department does not reveal that a particular application has been received unless and until it results in an accepted offer of financial assistance.



B. RESULTS

During the 1985/86 fiscal year, 2 281 applications were received bringing the number from inception to March 31, 1986, to a total of 9 878. This represents a monthly average of 190 applications compared with 333 per month in fiscal year 1984/85 and 403 in FY 1983/84. In general, there has been a substantial decrease in applications and authorized assistance during 1985/86 when compared to 1984/85.

Statistics on IRDP activities for each tier, from July 1, 1983, to March 31, 1986, are presented in **Table 1**. The data are based on all applications received since inception and reflect their disposition at March 31, 1986. The cumulative total of applications includes 27 cases received under the Regional Development Incentives Act (RDIA) and transferred to the IRDP in accordance with section 13 of the Industrial and Regional Development Act. A breakdown of applications received in 1985/86, by tier, is presented in **Table 2**.

**Tables 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7** present more detailed information on offers accepted for the current year and on a cumulative basis. **Tables 8, 9 and 10** present additional data for the current year only. These tables are discussed below.

1. Disposition of Applications Received

Included in the 2 434 assessments completed are 903 offers made and 10 projects authorized on which offers will be made early in 1986/87.

**Table 2** shows the number of applications received in 1985/86 in each tier. It can be seen that Tier II again has the highest proportion of applications received - 905, or 40 percent of the total. However, it should be noted that Tier IV has the highest number of applications per capita among all tiers.

**Table 3** shows offers accepted during the current fiscal year and the cumulative acceptances since inception of the program. The 891 offers accepted in 1985/86 have an IRDP contribution of \$302 million. This brings up the total number of accepted offers to 2 736 and the total amount of cumulative contribution to \$812 million since inception of the program. It should be noted that the 2 736 accepted offers represent 89 percent of the 3 071 offers made since the inception of the IRDP.

**Tables 3, 4, 6 and 7** provide a breakdown of these accepted offers by tier grouping, by program element, by size of assistance and by major industry groups respectively. **Table 5** shows the accepted offers equal to, or over \$5 million by planning element and tier. A detailed listing of each of the 891 offers accepted in 1985/86 appears in **Table 10**.

From **Table 3**, it can be seen that the largest proportion of offers accepted were in Tier II, 317 or 36 percent, followed closely by those accepted in Tier III, 304 or 34 percent, and in Tier I, 157 or 18 percent. However, the corresponding authorized assistance shows that Tier II had the largest proportion of total assistance, with \$88 million or 29 percent. Tier I followed closely with \$73 million or 25 percent, while Tiers III (\$69.7 million) and IV (\$69.7 million) accounted for 23 percent each of the total IRDP assistance. Overall, the number of offers accepted within each tier has decreased substantially since 1984/85. However, the dollar value of offers accepted in Tiers III and IV has increased from \$64.4 million and \$60.4 million respectively in 1984/85 to \$69.7 million and \$69.7 million respectively in 1985/86.

As can be seen in **Table 4**, the Modernization/Expansion program element, with 474 accepted offers, represented approximately 53 percent of total IRDP assistance for 1985/86. The Innovation element was a distant second with 215 offers accounting for only 24 percent of the total. Some 165 (or 19 percent of total offers) were accepted in the Establishment of new facility program element while only 20 offers (0.2 percent of the total) were accepted in the Marketing element reflecting the impact of the changes in eligibility for assistance in these elements as a result of the November 9, 1984, regulatory changes. The one offer accepted, in 1985/86, within the Restructuring element refers to an application received in the department prior to the November 1984 regulatory changes.

**Table 6** provides a breakdown of offers accepted by different amounts of assistance. It can be seen that 591 offers accepted or 66 percent of all offers were for less than \$100 000 in Crown contribution. However, these amount to only 10 percent of the total dollar value of authorized assistance under IRDP in 1985/86. Even though there were only 56 offers with assistance greater than \$1 million, the proportion in terms of dollar value of these large offers was more than 64 percent of total assistance. **Table 5** shows that, for the seven (7) accepted offers over \$5 million each, a total of \$92 million was provided. This corresponds to 29 percent of total IRDP assistance.

**Table 7** gives both the number of accepted offers and the authorized assistance for each major industry group eligible under the program. This table reveals that the metal fabricating industry, the wood industry and the machinery industry, which had 12.6 percent, 12.2 and 10.4 percent respectively of total offers, accounted for 23.2 percent of total assistance. On the other hand, the paper and allied industry had the highest proportion of financial assistance (21 percent) with only 1.1 percent of the number of accepted offers, followed by the transportation equipment sector with 18.5 percent of total assistance and 8.4 percent of the offers.

The "other" category, which accounts for 3.5 percent of the total IRDP authorized assistance, consists of sectors such as university education, computer services and business associations.

### 3. Benefits

One of the general IRDP program criteria stipulates that the project and exploitation of the results must represent significant economic benefits to Canada. Two of the main indicators of economic benefits in IRDP are the number of jobs created and/or maintained as a result of the authorized assistance and the leverage of private investment which measures the investment of the private sector in the projects being supported for each dollar contributed by the federal government.

**Table 8** provides a breakdown, by program element and by tier, of the leverage of private investment. This ratio is obtained by dividing the eligible costs of projects by the authorized assistance. Examination of this table reveals that the highest ratio, 8:1, is in the Restructuring element and Tier I at 5.5:1, followed by the Modernization/Expansion element at 5.6:1 and Tier I Special at 5.2:1. However, it should be noted that in 1985/86 there was only one offer accepted in the Restructuring element and six in the Tier I Special, which accounts for the higher ratios reported. The lowest leverage is for the Industrial Development Climate element at 1.6:1.

This means that for each dollar contributed by the federal government, the private sector has invested approximately \$5.5 in Tier I and \$5.6 in Modernization/Expansion related projects as opposed to only \$1.6 in Industrial Development Climate. The average leverage of private investment taken across all tiers and program elements in FY 85/86 is 5.0. Offers accepted for the Restructuring and Development Climate elements relate to applications received prior to the November 1984 regulatory changes.

The jobs to be created and maintained for each tier and for the Innovation, Establishment and Modernization/Expansion program elements are provided in **Table 9**. The average cost per job across the three program elements was estimated at \$7 921. The highest cost per job is in Tier IV at \$19 214, while the lowest was \$2 617 in Tier I Special.

No data or jobs are provided on the Marketing element since the only viable indicator of increased economic benefit remains the leverage of private investment as shown in **Table 8**.

EXPLANATION OF TERMS

This section identifies terms used in the report and provides a brief explanatory comment for each. These explanations are designed to facilitate understanding; they do not necessarily provide complete legal or administrative definitions nor do they depict all benefits, conditions, restraints or requirements that exist under the program. For specific purposes, reference should be made to the Industrial and Regional Development Act, the regulations made under that act, and other sources of official information.

1. Contribution: A contribution that is non-repayable, partially repayable, specifically repayable or one that is conditionally repayable under terms and conditions specified in the offer and accepted by the applicant.
  
2. Participation Loan: A loan for the establishment of a new facility or for the restructuring of a commercial operation which, by its terms, allows the minister to participate in the success by means of a stock option, a royalty on sales or production or otherwise; the rate of interest for a participation loan is equivalent to the lowest rate of interest charged by the Federal Business Development Bank on its term loans.
  
3. Grant: Assistance given to an applicant for a study, scholarship or course development relating to industrial development.
  
4. Application: A written submission by an applicant requesting assistance under the Industrial and Regional Development Act.
  - (a) Received: An application delivered to the department. The date of receipt is used for reporting and for establishing whether any prior commitment has occurred in respect of a cost of a proposed project or activity.
  
  - (b) Withdrawn: An application revoked by the applicant before or during evaluation.
  
  - (c) Rejected: An application for a project considered ineligible under the legislation, which would proceed without assistance, or which would make no significant economic or social contribution to Canada.

An application normally relates to a single project at a single site.

5. Offer Made: When an application has been evaluated and a grant or contribution authorized, the estimated amount of the grant or contribution and the related conditions are made known to the applicant in a formal letter of offer.
  - (a) Lapsed: If an applicant does not formally accept an offer within 90 days, the offer lapses.
  - (b) Withdrawn: If the department becomes aware of certain kinds of information prior to acceptance, it may revoke its offer.
  - (c) Declined: A formal decline of an offer by the applicant.
6. (a) Offer Accepted: Offer acceptance occurs when the applicant returns a signed copy of the offer within 90 days from its date.
  - (b) Offer withdrawn (after acceptance): If the department determines that legal requirements have not been met, it takes action to withdraw the offer, or if an applicant revokes his or her acceptance of an offer.
7. Final Payment Made: A final payment on account of contribution is made when the department is satisfied that all the conditions specified in the accepted offer have been met. The final payment for an establishment, expansion or modernization project cannot be made until 24 months after the certified date of commercial production. For all other projects, the final payment is made on completion of the project.
8. Project Location: The location of the project based on information provided by the applicant.
9. SIC Code: The Standard Industrial Classification System 1980 established by Statistics Canada for standardizing definitions and techniques in the gathering and compilation of statistics related to industries in Canada.
10. Program Elements:
  - (a) Climate: Projects under the Industrial Development Climate element of IRDP for the establishment of a non-profit centre or institute relating to industrial development, for an economic development study, for specialized services, for infrastructure development or for course development or scholarships.

- (b) Innovation: Projects for the development of a new or improved product or production process, for the design of new, mass-producible durable products, for the improvement or expansion of technological capability, or for research and development in the area of pollution abatement technology.
  - (c) New facility: Establishment of a new facility to manufacture goods, or provide services (tourism).
  - (d) Modernization: A change or addition made to an existing facility primarily designed to reduce production costs, improve product quality, and which can include replacements of existing fixed assets, with or without the use of micro-electronic devices.
  - (e) Expansion: An addition to an existing facility to increase the output of the commodity or service on the same site, or a relocation of a facility.
  - (f) Marketing: Projects for collecting and disseminating information, arranging a special event or conference to develop and increase the market of tourism operations, or to increase the marketing of the products or services of these operations; also for literature, advertising, trade shows, seminars, market research and analysis, and promotion of Canadian standards and product specifications to increase the marketing of the products or services of commercial operations.
  - (g) Restructuring: A change with respect to the products, methods of production, services, markets or management procedures of a commercial operation that is in need of renewal.
11. Estimated Eligible Cost: The costs of a development climate, innovation, establishment, expansion, modernization, marketing or restructuring project, as estimated by the department on the basis of information supplied by an applicant, covering only costs that are eligible for a grant, contribution or participation loan.
12. Authorized Amount of Assistance: The departmental grant, contribution or participation loan to be paid, based on the terms of the accepted contract.
