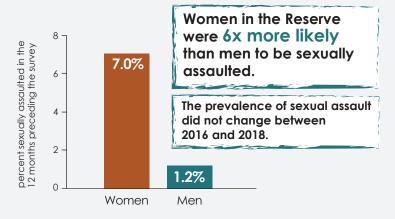

Sexual assault



Note: Includes incidents of sexual assault which occurred in the military workplace or involving other military members. Sexual assault includes sexual attacks, unwanted sexual touching, or sexual activity without the ability to consent.

In 2018, similar to 2016:

Between 2016 and 2018:



the percentage of victims who said that someone in authority found out about the incident **increased**.

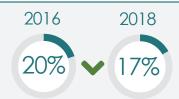
Sexualized or discriminatory behaviours

7 in 10 Primary Reserve members



witnessed or experienced sexualized or discriminatory behaviour in the past 12 months, down from 8 in 10 in 2016.

5 in 10 women and **4 in 10** men who witnessed sexualized or discriminatory behaviour in 2018 **took action.**



Reservists personally targeted

- In 2018, 34% of women and 13% of men were personally targeted by sexualized or discriminatory behaviour.
- Reporting of targeted behaviours to someone in authority increased from 25% in 2016 to 30% in 2018.

Note: Represents statistically significant changes between 2016 and 2018.
