


The objective of free trade agreements is to increase trade with partner countries by reducing tariff barriers and opening access to foreign markets. At present, there are **14 FREE TRADE AGREEMENTS** currently in force in Canada involving **51 COUNTRIES**. Canada's trade with these countries accounted for **78.5**% of Canada's **IMPORTS** and **89.7**% of Canada's **EXPORTS** in 2018.
