

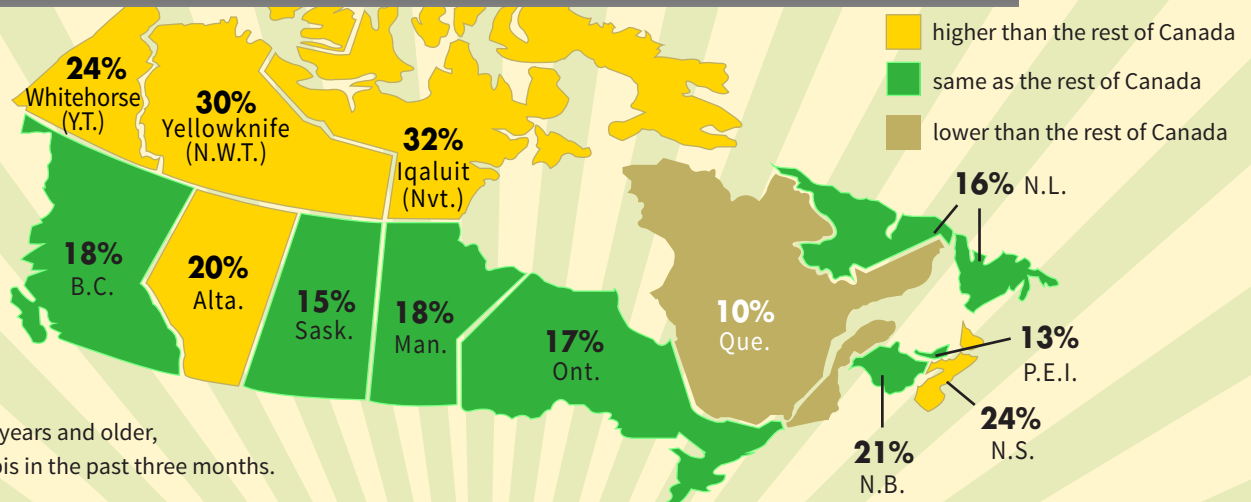


# National Cannabis Survey

## 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter, 2019

Statistics Canada is conducting the National Cannabis Survey **every three months** throughout 2019. These data are about Canadians, 15 and older, and reflect their cannabis use and related behaviours in the **past three months**.

### Cannabis use by province and territorial capitals – 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter, 2019

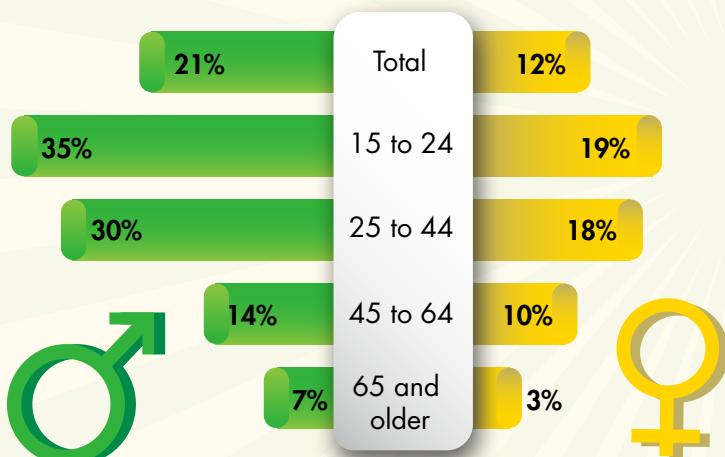

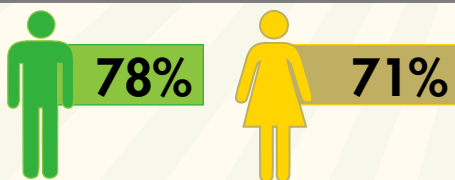
Percentage of Canadians 15 years and older, who have consumed cannabis in the past three months.

### HOW CANNABIS CONSUMPTION DIFFERS BY GENDER

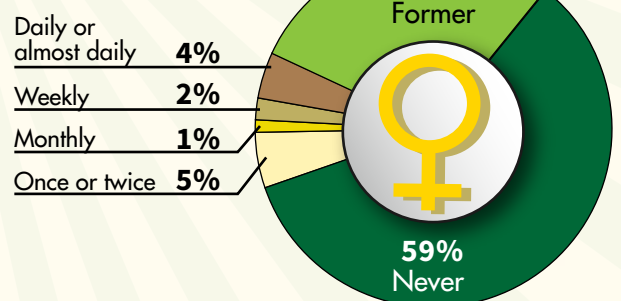
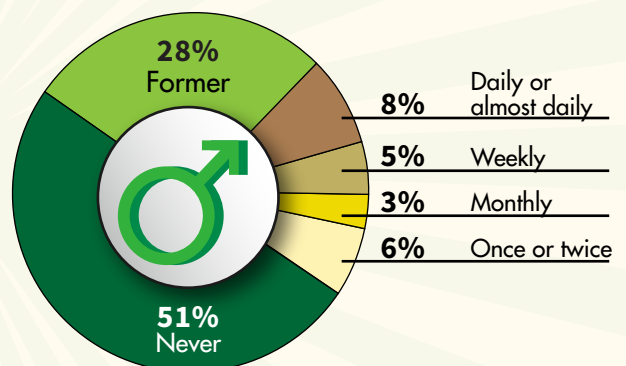
Males more likely to use cannabis in all age groups, except seniors aged 65 or older



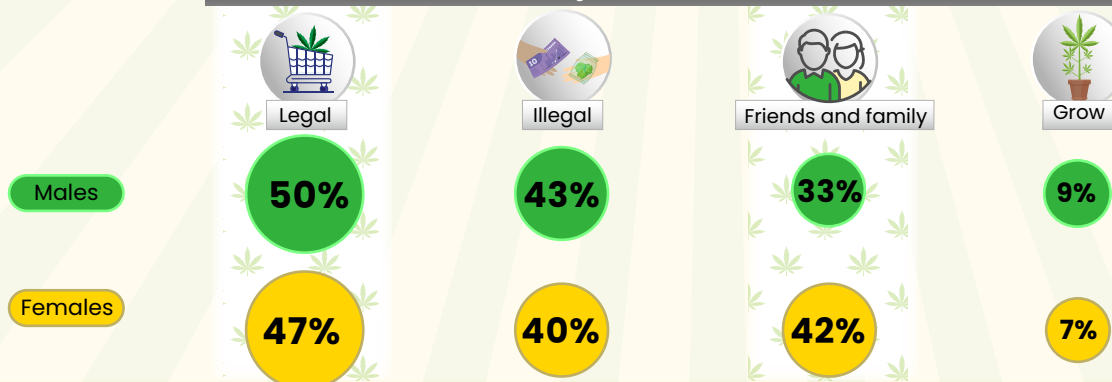
Males more likely to buy cannabis than females
