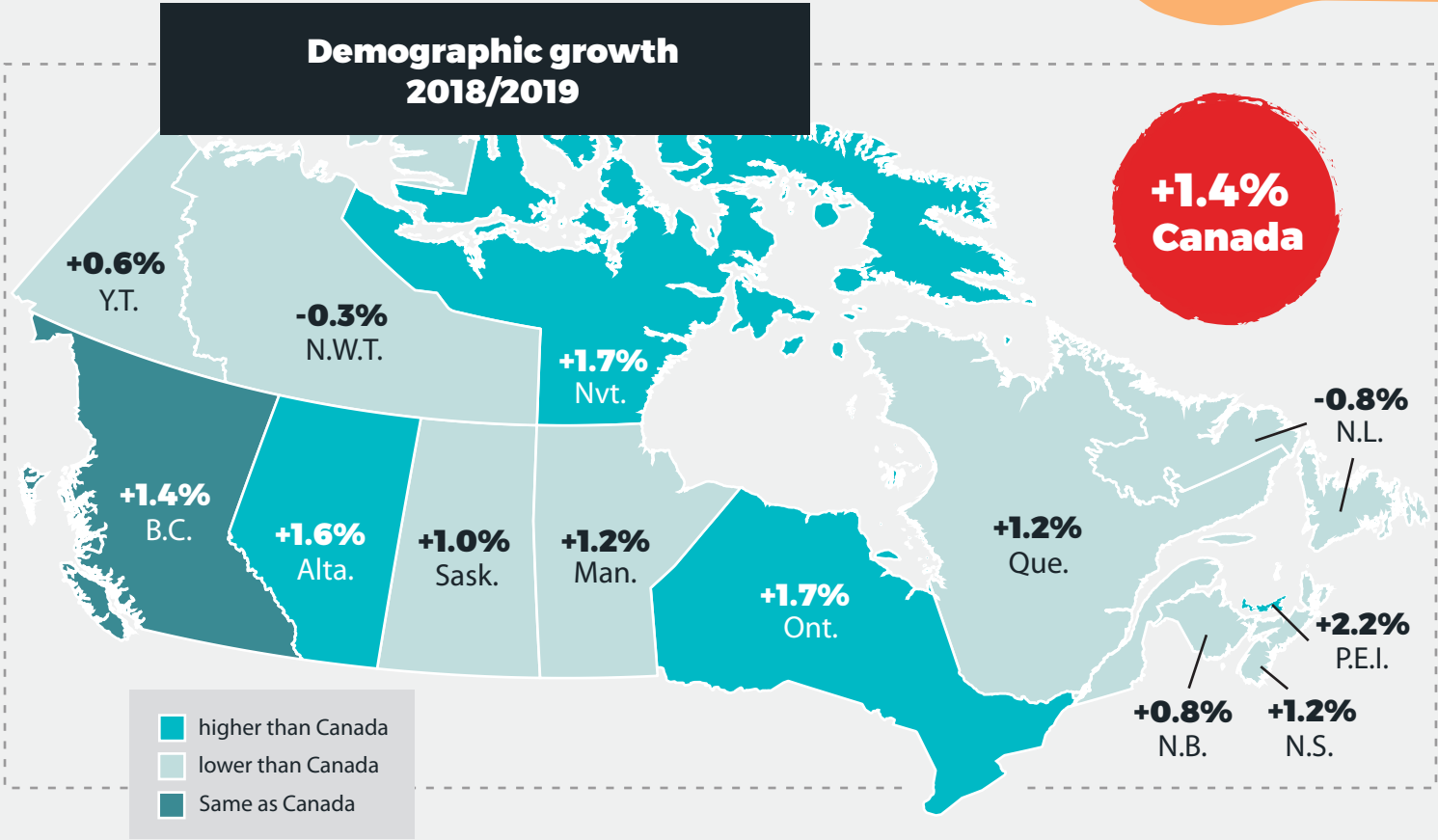
The largest annual growth in history.

37.6 million  
on July 1, 2019,



up more than half a million people  
(+531,497).

Canada's population growth rate was also the **highest** among all **G7** countries.



On July 1, 2019, there were **6,592,611 Canadians aged 65 and over**. For the first time, baby-boomers make up the majority (**51%**) of seniors.



International migration was the **main driver** of population growth over the last year.

Factors of growth in 2018/2019:

Temporary and permanent immigration.

Natural increase (difference between the number of births and deaths).

Because of increased life expectancy, the number of **centenarians (10,795)** has grown very fast in recent years.
