# Perceptions related to gender equality in Canada, 2018 

Examining attitudes and beliefs can provide further insight on how certain behaviours are perceived by Canadians.
This information can shed light on the areas where further conversations about social norms and attitudes may be beneficial.

## More than 7 in 10 Canadians agree that:


same- and opposite-sex partners should
have the same rights to adopt children
people should be able to express their gender however they choose


The largest differences between women's and men's attitudes were seen in the levels of agreement with these two statements:



The majority of Canadians said they would support a transgender family member
while 1 in 10 stated that they would not.
